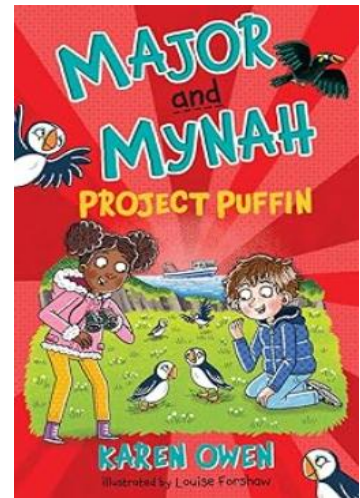

BECOME AN ECO WARRIOR!

Our planet is huge and we all need to play a part in looking after it. It's important we do this so that everyone has a clean and safe place to live. Here are Callie and Grace's top tips:



Become a litter hero!

Just spending ten minutes picking up litter can make a difference straight away. This can be at the beach, in a park, or even in your street. In *Project Puffin*, Callie and Grace learn how to do this safely. They say you must remember:



- Wear gloves
- Use a little picker if you can
- Don't touch any dead birds because they might carry disease
- Dispose of the rubbish responsibly

Become a citizen scientist!

Join in with a beach clean and make a careful record of what you discover.

- ? How much litter did you find?
- ? What animals did you see at the coast?
- ? What type of seaweed did you spot?

Then you can share your scientific data with environmental groups such as the Marine Conservation Society. They collect it to understand what is happening with our ocean, and use it to create campaigns calling for change. It's a key part of their work and you can be part of it.

Recycle

Where does rubbish go? In the bin! Then it's collected by refuse teams and taken away. In the UK, each person creates about 400kg of waste every year. That's the same as an average sized horse or a grand piano.

But the rubbish doesn't magically disappear. Instead, it gets buried in the ground in huge holes called landfill. Landfills are bad for the environment because the rubbish may contain toxic chemicals or give off harmful gases. They also take up a lot of space and we can't use that ground for growing fruit, vegetables, or crops.



The good news is that some of our rubbish can be recycled. This includes paper, card, and certain types of plastics. Find out what can be put in the recycling bin in your area. Remember: less waste means less landfill.

Volunteer

Join an eco club at school or in your local area and take part in environmental projects such as making your own compost.

Learn about campaigns by eco groups such as Keep Britain Tidy.

Design a poster to urge visitors to take their rubbish home or to keep our beaches and countryside clean. Display it at school or public spaces like your library or youth club (remember to ask for permission first).
